Notice

If this objection is lodged against the processing of personal data indicated by letter c), the personal data will no longer be processed for these purposes. These measures shall be taken by the Administrator without undue delay, but no later than one month from the receipt of this objection. If necessary, this period may be extended by a further two months due to the complexity and number of objections. If the Administrator does not take the required measures, the Objector is entitled to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority (Office for Personal Data Protection) and seek judicial protection.

If the Administrator has reasonable doubts as to the identity of the individual raising the objection, he may request additional information necessary to confirm the identity of the data subject.

If the Administrator concludes that the applicable right does not suit the objector, he is obliged to justify this conclusion in writing and duly, within the above-mentioned period.

The Objector further acknowledges that in the event that his personal data are processed for scientific, historical, statistical or archival purposes in the public interest, his right to objection under Article 21 of the General Regulation may be limited, based on the law of the European Union, or the law of the Czech Republic, but only if its law would prevent or seriously jeopardize the fulfilment of the special purposes of the Administrator.
